



**King Harbor Yacht Club**  
**2017 “Twilights”**  
**SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**  
**(HARBOR ENTRANCE FINISHES)**

1. **RULES:** This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (2017-2020), these Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race. “RRS” 82 shall not apply.
2. **ENTRIES:**
  - 2.1 Boats may be entered by completing registration with the host Club: KHYC.
  - 2.2 Boats may check in prior to their start for each race in one of three ways:
    - At the Registration Desk prior to 1730.
    - By contacting the RC on VHF channel 78 prior their warning signal and receiving confirmation.
    - By sailing past the RC Boat on starboard tack (avoiding all boats whose preparatory signal has been made) prior to their warning signal and receiving confirmation.

**Boats that check in and fail to start must notify the Race Committee on VHF Channel 78.**
3. **RACE COMMITTEE**

All competitors in this series are expected to provide 2 individuals to support the Race Committee at least once per season.
4. **NOTICE TO COMPETITORS:**

Notices to competitors will be posted on the Regatta Notice Board located at KHYC by 1700 of the day of the race.
5. **SCHEDULE OF RACES:** Schedule of races is described in the Notice of Race.
6. **CLASS DESIGNATIONS:** Class designations are described in the Notice of Race.
7. **THE COURSE:**
  - 7.1 All courses will be selected from KHYC TWILIGHT RACE CHART 2017.
  - 7.2 Course signals will be displayed from the Race Committee Boat by placard at the Warning Signal for the next Class to start.
  - 7.3 **The start line is restricted. Boats already started shall not pass through the start line.**
8. **START:**
  - 8.1 Races will be started in accordance with Racing Rule 26 with Classes starting in the sequence described in the Notice of Race.
  - 8.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the Race Committee boat and an orange flag in the water, in the vicinity of “Y”. A boat whose Preparatory Signal has not been made shall keep clear of all boats whose Preparatory Signal has been made. Boats violating this rule will be disqualified!

# Sailing Instructions

## 9. RECALLS:

**9.1** Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with Racing Rule 29.1. The Race committee may hail sail numbers on VHF Channel 78. If no hail is given, **this is not grounds for redress.**

General recalls will be signaled in accordance with Racing Rule 29.2. The class being recalled shall go to the end of the scheduled class starts.

## 10. THE FINISH:

**10.1** The “**Finish Line**” will be at the harbor entrance on a line of sight between the “**Orange Flag**” on the Race Committee Boat and the “**Redondo Beach East Jetty Light 2**”. A racing boat shall be finished when the Race Committee Boat acknowledges with a sound. “**W**” mark is a mark of the course and shall be left to port.

**10.2** If the Race Committee Boat is not on station when the first boat finishes, that boat shall take their own finish time at W-Mark and that of all subsequent boats until relieved by the RC.

**10.3** The Race Committee Boat will be on station until **2000** hours. Boats finishing after that time will take their own time when crossing the finish line (@ W mark) and without delay advise the Race Committee via Ch. VHF 78 or cell phone 310-488-7129.

**10.4** **All boats** that are flying Spinnakers at the finish, must release a control line promptly at the finish line.

**10.5** **Boats** retiring from the race must advise the Race Committee without delay, either on Ch. 78 VHF or cell phone 310-488-7129.

## 11. PENALTY SYSTEM:

The “Two Turn Penalty” is replaced with a “One Turn Penalty”; modifying Rules 44.1 & 44.2. Rule 44.3 shall not apply.

## 12. PROTESTS:

Protests must be on written forms available at the host Club KHYC, and filed within 30 minutes after the Committee boat docks. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after the conclusion of each race.

## 13. SCORING:

Time on Time scoring will be used.

## 14. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS:

The Race committee will monitor **VHF Channel 78**.
