

NOTICE OF RACE Midwinter Tune up Regatta February 18th 2023 This event is organized by the KHYC Model Yacht Fleet

1. Rules

1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and by Appendix E, Radio Sailing Racing Rules, except as changed in this Notice and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This regatta is limited to 30 boats.
- 2.2. Entry form must be received by the organizing authority prior to the regatta date.
- 2.3. This regatta is open to all DF95 model sailboats.

3. Fee

3.1. Entry fee is \$10 for this regatta.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Racing will start as soon as possible following the skippers meeting at 12:30 p.m.
- 4.2. There will be one practice race, not scored.
- 4.3. 10 races are scheduled.
- 4.4. 5 races constitute a regatta.
- 4.5. Each race will be started as soon as possible following the previous race using a 2-minute audio starting sequence.
- 4.6. Boats must be in the water, sailing at the one-minute mark before start to be scored in that race.
- 4.7. At the conclusion of 5 races, there will be a short intermission.
- 4.8. If more than 16 competitors are entered, entrants will be randomly divided into a blue and yellow fleet.
- 4.9. Each Fleet will race a 4-race preliminary round.
- 4.10. The top half of each fleet will race together in a 3-race championship round to determine trophy winners.
- 4.11. There will be no throw-outs in the championship round.

5. Sailing Instructions

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at time of registration.
- 5.2. Any conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the Notice of the race, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedent.

6. Scoring

- 6.1. Appendix A low point scoring system will be used.
- 6.2. There will be 1 throw out if 4 or more races and 2 throw outs if 8 or more races.
- 6.3. There will be no throw outs in the championship round.

7. Trophies

7.1. Trophies will be presented at the KHYC Patio following the conclusion of the races and completion of scoring.

8. Disclaimer of Liability

8.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
