NOTICE OF RACE

THE MATT WALSH RACE (Spinnaker #5) **FIFTH RACE OF THE KHYC SPINNAKER SERIES** **SATURDAY, September 15, 2012**

RULES: This race will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event. This race is a Category 4 event.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold a current PHRF certificate will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. Multihulls are invited. At least three entries will constitute a class. Advance registration by mail must be received at KHYC by Sept. 14th. There will be a \$15 entry fee.

VENUE: The race area will be per the KHYC 2012 Race Mark Guide and the Sailing Instructions available at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

DIVISIONS: Based on the entrants in the 1st race of the series, PHRF class splits, using PHRF Area-B Buoy ratings are as follows: A (137 or less) - B (138 or higher). Multihulls are welcome.

SCHEDULE OF RACES: There will be one race of approximately 12.9 nm.

The course will be: **K-10 PV-K-H-X-H-P-W-Finish**

STARTS: In the vicinity of "K" mark. The first warning for "B" boats will be at 1155. "B" boats will start at 1200. "A" boats' warning will be at 1225, start at 1230. (Note: The Multihull boats will start in the interval between the "B" start at 1200 and the "A" warning signal at 1225.)

FINISH: The finish is just inside the harbor entrance between an orange flag on the RC boat and the Redondo Beach East Jetty Light (#2) at the harbor entrance.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Random Course ratings will apply with TOT scoring for this race.

TROPHIES: Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. The Matt Walsh Perpetual trophy will be awarded at the KHYC annual awards event (PHRF A&B).

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. The bar opens at 1500 and post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
