## **NOTICE OF RACE (REVISION 2)**

**Rules:** This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. RRS 82 shall not apply. *This is a female at the helm event.* All female crews and mixed crews are welcome. A female must be at the helm for the majority of the race, including the start, finish and rounding all marks.

**Entries:** The regatta is open to all boats whose owners are members of yacht clubs and sailing associations recognized by the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA) or US Sailing. All boats must have a valid rating certificate. Class splits will be determined by the number of entrants and will be posted on the Official Notice Board at KHYC by 1030. Three or more boats may establish a class. **Entry Forms** will be accepted by mail (provided they are received by Friday, April 27<sup>th</sup>), fax (310-374-5848) or at KHYC before 1030 on race day. **Entry Fee** is \$20 per vessel.

**Courses:** Three races are scheduled. One race will constitute the regatta. No score will be excluded. This modifies RRS A2. Sailing Instructions and courses will be available at registration.

**Venue:** Start in the vicinity of "S" Mark per the 2012 KHYC Race Course Guide. Sail by the RC Boat prior to the first warning to be recognized as a starter. The first warning will be at 1155. **Finish:** The finish line is the same as the start line.

**Penalty System:** RRS 41.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

Radio Communication: The RC monitors channel 78a.

**Protests:** Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat and notify the RC., when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the RC boat arrives at the from dock with race results.

**Trophies:** Individual trophies will be awarded at the Redondo Beach Yacht Club following the race.

**Facilities:** All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the races. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call Julie Coll, the regatta chairperson, or the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the guest dock.
