

September 8, 2012 Notice of Race

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. Rule 82 does not apply.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to members of SCYA recognized Yacht Clubs and Sailing Associations, and to any One Design Fleet which establishes a class of three (3) or more entries. Classes expected are: Cal 20, Laser, Flying Junior, Capri 14, Multihull, Far 30, Martin 242, Ben 36.7, Open 5.7, Star, J24 and Portsmouth. If a minimum of 3 boats is not achieved for any particular class competitors will automatically be entered into the Portsmouth handicap class (*three boat minimum required*).

Entries: Entries mailed to King Harbor Yacht Club, 280 Yacht Club Way, Redondo Beach, CA 90277 or placed in the office at KHYC must be received by Thursday, September 6th. Late entries for established classes will be accepted at the Club up to *1030* on Saturday, September 8th, 2012.

Entry Fee: Entries must be accompanied by a check made payable to King Harbor Yacht Club. Fees will be \$20.00 if <u>received</u> by Thursday, September 6th and \$25.00 thereafter.

Venue & Races: An attachment to the Sailing Instructions will show the location of the racing area and the courses to be sailed will be Windward/Leeward. Three (3) races are scheduled. Completion of One (1) race shall constitute a regatta.

Starting Order: Established classes, starting order and class breaks will be posted at the Club by 1030, September 8th, 2012. First warning will be at 1155.

Sailing Instructions and Courses: Sailing Instructions will be available at the Registration Desk on the morning of the race and on the KHYC website: www.khyc.org.

Protests: As prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

Penalty System: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. Rule 44.3 does not apply.

Scoring: Appendix A4 Low Point Scoring will be applied. No Score will be excluded.

Facilities: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.

Trophies: Trophies will be presented at King Harbor Yacht Club as soon as possible after completion of races.
