## Tri Mix Challenge Race (Spinnaker #4)

## Fourth RACE OF THE KHYC SPINNAKER SERIES SATURDAY, June 11, 2011

**RULES**: This race will be governed by the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing. The prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event. This race is a Category 4 event.

**ENTRIES:** Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold a current PHRF certificate will be accepted at KHYC from 0900 until 1030 on race day. Multihulls are invited, at least three entries will constitute a class. Advance registration by mail must be received at KHYC by June 10th. There will be a \$15 entry fee.

<u>VENUE:</u> The race area will be per the KHYC 2011 Race Mark Guide and the Sailing Instructions available at the Registration Desk on Race Day.

<u>DIVISIONS</u>: Based on the entrants in the 1st race of the series, PHRF class splits, using PHRF Area-B Buoy ratings, are as follows: A (137 or less) - B (138 or higher). This is a Category 4 event and a mix of Buoy and RLC ratings will apply for scoring.

**SCHEDULE OF RACES:** Three races are scheduled per the Spinnaker 4 Course Chart. One race will constitute the regatta. There will be no throw-outs.

**STARTS:** In the vicinity of "P" mark per Spinnaker 4 Course Chart. The first warning will be at 1155. Subsequent class starts are at 5 minute intervals.

**FINISH:** Per Spinnaker 4 Course Chart.

**PENALTY SYSTEM:** Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

**SCORING:** The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A.4 will apply as a single race event. PHRF Buoy ratings will apply for Races I & 2 and RLC ratings for Race 3, with TOT scoring for this race.

**TROPHIES:** Individual trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. The H.A Sims perpetual trophy (PHRF A & B) will be awarded at the KHYC annual awards event.

<u>FACILITIES:</u> All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Post race hors d'oeuvres will be served. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
