

# King Harbor Yacht Club 2010 Twilight Series Notice of Race

## 1. RULES

The Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012), this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions, shall govern this series. Sailing instructions will be available at KHYC.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY

The series is open to all sail boats with LOA of 20 ft or more. PHRF Buoy rating handicaps will be applied. Boats without a PHRF rating shall notify the HRF Fleet Captain prior to the race to obtain a rating based on similar boat handicaps. Three boats will be required to form a fleet.

## 3. ENTERING AND ENTRY FEE

Boats may enter by completing a KHYC Twilight Entry Card prior to 1730 hours PDT on the day of the first race in which it competes. Only one Entry Card is required for the entire series. The entry fee is payable either *before 1730 PDT* on the day of the race or in advance for the entire series. Registration Committee will be available at KHYC prior to each race to receive entries and fees. Fees are \$5.00 per race. Series discounts are available for those signing up in advance for the series. Boats failing to enter and pay the fee prior to the race <u>will not be scored</u>.

### 4. CLASSES AND RACE SCHEDULE

Races will be held **Thursday evenings beginning 3/24/11 and ending 9/15/11**. The warning signal for the first start will be at 18:10 PDT. Start time and classes are as follows:

1815 Cal 20 (class flag "F") 1820 PHRF-A (rating to 137) class flag "D" 1825 PHRF-R (rating to 137) class flag "R" 1830 PHRF-B (rating 140 & up) class flag "E" 1835 Martin 242 (class flag "W")

Boats wishing to compete as non-spinnaker in Class A or B must declare their status at time of sign-up to receive their PHRF spinnaker offset. The Race Committee has the discretion to change starting sequences and/or combine starts with proper signaling.

#### 5. COURSES AND STARTS

All courses will be selected from KHYC Twilight Race Chart for 2011. *The start line is restricted until the last class has started.* 

#### 6. TIME LIMIT

Boats not finishing by 2000 will be scored as DNF

#### 7. TROPHIES AND SEASON SCORING

Individual race trophies will be awarded by class after each race with the number of trophies determined by class size and KHYC Trophy Policy. One automatic first place will be awarded per season for a boat that does not compete because of Race Committee duty. RRS(A4.2) is modified as follows: Season scoring will be low point: 1 point for first. DNS or DNF will be scored "number of starters +1 point", for DSQ number of starters +2 points. "*Time on Time*" scoring will be used. The series will consist of two halves, with trophies awarded for each half and for the entire series. Two throw outs will be applied for each half. A boat must enter at least 50% of races for the series to qualify as a participant
