





Champion of Champions Regatta Saturday & Sunday 25 – 26 September 2010 NOTICE OF RACE King Harbor Yacht Club

The ASMBYC Champion of Champions Regatta will be hosted by King Harbor (KHYC) and Port Royal Yacht Clubs (PRYC) on Saturday and Sunday, September 25-26, 2010. KHYC is located 280 Yacht Club Way, Redondo Beach, California 90277. Information about KHYC and this regatta is available at www.khyc.org.

1. RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules of racing as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the ASMBYC Championship Regatta Rules.
- 1.2 The Organizing Authority (OA) is KHYC and PRYC in conjunction with the Associations of Santa Monica Bay Yacht Clubs (ASMBYC).
- 1.3 The Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (SoCalPHRF) "Marine Industry Racer" rule will not apply to this event.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 This is an invitational regatta. Entrants must qualify per the ASMBYC Championship Regatta Rules. In summary, a skipper qualifies if he/she achieved "Trophy Status" in one of the Qualifying Series/Races set forth in the 2010 Yearbook and Calendar (page 24). "Trophy status" is defined as finishing in the top 1/3rd of your class in any of the ASMBYC Qualifying Series/Races. For purpose of qualification, a skipper and boat shall be considered a single entity.
- 2.2 Each boat must (1) be entered by an individual who is a member of an ASMBYC member yacht club or sailing association and (2) fulfill the eligibility requirements of the class in which she will compete. One design boats that have not established a class will race in PHRF fleet without requirement for PHRF membership. Four (4) boats constitute a class.
- 2.3 Each entrant must submit a completed KHYC entry form with appropriate fee to ASMBYC by 1900 hours (7:00 PM) Thursday September 23, 2010.
- 2.4 Each Cruising Class entrant must also comply with paragraph 2,3 and submit a completed ASMBYC Cruiser Class Universal Boat Handicapping Form.
- 2.5 Late entries will not be accepted.

3. CLASSES

3.1 Classes will be established for PHRF, One-Design and Cruising Classes based on the entries established by the deadline set forth in 2.3 above.

Classes, class flags and the order of start will be posted no later than 2000 (8:00 PM) on Friday, September 24, 2010.

4. FEES

The entry fee is \$40.00 for members of US Sailing with proof of membership, \$45 for non-members. For Cruiser classes, the fee is \$25.00 for non-members of US Sailing or \$20.00 with proof of US Sailing membership. Information about joining US Sailing is available at www.ussailing.org.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Five (5) races are scheduled, three (3) on Saturday and two (2) on Sunday. For the Cruising Class, two (2) races are scheduled on Sunday only.

Without posting a change to the schedule of races, the Race Committee (RC) reserves the Right to run one or more races on Sunday if fewer than the scheduled number of races are completed on Saturday. The RC at its discretion may run fewer total races. One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

Hor d'oeurves will be furnished after each days racing. Trophies will be presented on Sunday, September 26, 2010 after racing.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing Instructions (SI's) will be available on line at www.khyc.org and www.asmbyc.org. and at the sign -in desk.

7. RACING AREA

The starting area is west of the breakwater off King Harbor.

8. COURSES

Courses will be primarily windward/leeward selected from the KHYC chart 2010. For the Cruising Class, random leg courses will be selected from the KHYC 2010 chart.

9. **SCORING**

- 9.1 PHRF classes will be scored using Area B Buoy Ratings.
- 9.2 The Cruising Class will use handicaps based on the ASMBYC Cruiser Class Universal Boat Handicapping Form as submitted by each entrant.

10. ON-THE- WATER COMMUNICATION

The RC will be monitoring channel 78 including starting penalties.
