## **Sailing Instructions**

## Midwinter Regatta February 20 & 21, 2010

## King Harbor Yacht Club

#### 1. Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing.

#### 2. Entries

Competitors may enter by delivering a completed entry form and paying the fee as stated on the Notice of Race on the morning of February 20th 10:00 A.M. All mailed entries must be received by this time.

### 3. Notices to Competitors

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located on the first floor. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 10:30 A.M. both days. Changes to the S.I.s may be made orally by the race committee on the water.

### 4. Signals Made Ashore

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located on the East Patio. If a postponement is signaled ashore, the warning signal will not be made less than one hour after the AP is lowered.

#### 5. Schedule

A competitors' meeting will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, February 20th, in the Cole Room. The warning signal for the first race, Saturday, will be at 11:55 A.M. Subsequent races will be held as soon as possible after the end of the previous race. The first warning on Sunday will be at 12:55 P.M. A total of five races are planned. (Three on Saturday and two Sunday) Weather will determine the number of races. One race will constitute the regatta.

#### 6. Class Flags

The class flag for the PHRF A fleet is	"K"
The class flag for the PHRF B fleet is	"U"
The class flag for the One design fleet is	"F"
The class flag for NACRA is	"G"

#### SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - SCYA MIDWINTER REGATTA

Protests shall be delivered to the Race Committee Room within 45 minutes after the race committee boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests will be posted on the Notice Board. Protests will be heard as soon as possible after racing each day.

### 12. Scoring

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply.

### 13. Penalty System

Rule 44 is changed so that the 720-degree turn is replaced with a 360-degree turn.

## 14. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded on Sunday as soon as possible after the event. Trophies are to be presented by SCYA on the upper deck of the clubhouse.

#### 15. Hospitality

Hors d'oeuvres will be served on the upper deck after each day's racing.

The race committee will communicate over channel 78. Racers are advised to keep this channel open.
