
Fall Sabot Cup

Hosted by King Harbor Yacht Club

October 16, 2010

- 1. <u>Rules</u>: The Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing and the bylaws and prescriptions of the US Sabot Association.
- 2. **Entries**: The regatta is open to all members of the US Sabot Association in good standing. There will be three Junior Divisions, A, B, and C.
- 3. Notice to Competitors: Notices will be posted on the Regatta Notice Board on the KHYC Lower Deck.
- 4. <u>Changes in Sailing Instructions</u>: Any changes in the sailing instructions will be posted before 1000 hrs on the day of the regatta. Changes can be found on the Regatta Notice Board
- 5. Skippers Meeting and Schedule of Races: There will be a Skipper's meeting at 0945 hrs on the KHYC Lower Deck. First warning signal will be at 1100 hrs on both race courses. The A and B fleets will start on the outside race course and the C fleet will start on the inside course. The A fleet will start first on the outside course followed 3 min later by the B fleet. Subsequent races on each course will start as soon as possible after the finish of the last boat. No race will be started after 1430 hrs. THERE WILL BE NO BREAK FOR LUNCH, SO PLEASE EAT BEFORE DEPARTING FOR THE RACE COURSE OR TAKE SUFFICIENT FOOD AND BEVERAGES WITH YOU.
- 7. Racing Area: The racing area for the A and B fleets will be outside the King Harbor entrance approx 0.25 mi SE of the King Harbor bell buoy. The race area for the C fleet will be in "C" basin immediately inside of the King Harbor entrance. Both venues are shown on the attached course chart. NOTE: SPECTATORS MAY WATCH THE C FLEET FROM THE PORTOFINO INN AND YACHT CLUB PARKING LOT LOCATED AT THE WEST END OF BERYL STREET.
- 8. <u>Courses</u>: See the attached course charts. All marks will be rounded to Port. Course numbers will be on a white board on the race committee boat.
- 9. <u>Marks</u>: For the A and B fleets, the marks will be orange tetrahedron marks. For C the marks will be small red inflatables.
- 10. <u>The Start/Finish</u>: For the A and B fleets, the start/finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange or red flag on the Race Committee boat and an orange or red flag buoy. For C fleet, the start/finish line will be between an orange or red flag on the R/C boat and a small red inflatable. Rule 26 is changed to include a warning at 3 minutes. After starting and before finishing, any boat crossing the start finish line will be disqualified.
- 11. <u>Recalls</u>: Individual recalls will be signaled in accordance with Rule 29.1. The Race Committee will attempt to hail sail numbers, however, failure to be hailed is insufficient cause for granting redress.
- 12. **Scoring**: The low-point scoring system, Rule A2, will apply. A minimum of 3 races shall constitute a completed regatta. The race committee will attempt to run 8 races, weather permitting. If more than 6 races are completed a contestant's score shall be the sum of his/her race finishes excluding his/her worst finish.
- 13. <u>Protests</u>: Protests must be filed with the Race Committee no later than 45 minutes after the Committee boat reaches the dock. The time limit will be posted on the official notice board upon arrival ashore of the Race Committee. Protest forms will be available from the race room on the KHYC Lower Deck.
- 14. <u>Penalties</u>: A 360 degree turn is required for clearing of penalty for breaking a rule of part 2 while racing. This modifies rule 44.1 of the RRS.
- 16. <u>Safety</u>: All competitors shall comply with Section 6 of the US Sabot Assoc ByLaws, requiring (a) wearing USCG approved Personal Flotation Devices, appropriately secured, while on the water (b) a bailer of at least 1 qt capacity with lanyard connecting bailer to the boat, (c) Paddle with handle, blade >30 in² in area, (d) painter >1/4 in dia extending >8 ft past center of the bow, with one end secured to the mast step.
- 17. <u>Trophies</u>: Trophies will be awarded as soon as possible after racing, depending on duration of protest hearings.
- 18. Social: Snacks and sodas will be available after the races on the KHYC Lower Deck.




Outside Course Chart, A & B Fleets 2010 Fall Sabot Cup











