RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012. The Cal 20 Association Constitution and By-Laws constitute class rules.

ELIGIBILITY

The regatta is open to skippers representing a yacht club or association recognized by the IYRU or USSA and who meet the requirements of the Cal-20 Rules. All entrants' boats require a valid measurement certificate and all sails must have a valid measurement stamp. Junior skippers must have been born after July 23, 1991. Master skippers must have been born before July 23, 1949.

ENTRY FEE

Please return the attached entry form with a check payable to King Harbor Yacht Club. Entries postmarked by July 1, 2009 will be eligible for the entry fee of \$100.00. Entries postmarked later than July 1, 2009 will pay the entry fee of \$140.00

REGISTRATION

To be considered a competitor in the events, a valid copy of your boat's measurement certificate and a copy of membership in a yacht

club or association recognized by U.S. Sailing must be received by the registration deadline.
