LAST RACE OF THE 2002 RACING SEASON

DIVISIONS: Three boats will constitute a class. PHRF splits and order of start will be posted at KHYC by 1030 on race day.

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold valid ratings will be accepted by mail and at KHYC until 1030 on race day. There will be a \$13.00 entry fee for non-USSA members and \$10.00 for USSA members. Advance registration is requested.

COURSES: Courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions available at registration. All Fleets will race three races if time and weather permit.

STARTS: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The first warning will be at 1200. The order of start may change for the second or third race. Observe all placard and/or flag changes on the Committee boat.

FINISHES: The same as the start line.

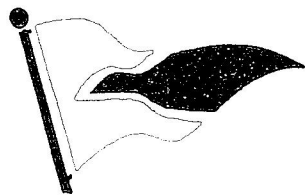

RULES: The race will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA, Class Rules and the sailing Instructions available at the Registration table. Boats that do not finish must notify the Race Committee as soon as possible after retiring. Competitors must sail by the Race Committee boat prior to the first warning to be classified as a starter.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat and notify the RC when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the RC boat arrives at the front dock.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the race. **There will be a prize for the crew showing the most Christmas spirit.** This is the last regatta of the season, so all participants are urged to share in the after-race festivities at the Club.

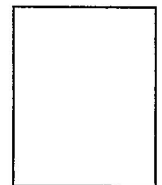
