THIRD RACE OF THE SPINNAKER SERIES

DIVISIONS: Class splits are as follows: A-(0-149), B-(150-999). **ENTRIES**: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold valid PHRF ratings will be accepted by mail or at KHYC until 1030 on race day. There will be a \$10.00 entry fee for USSA members and \$13.00 for non-USSA members.

COURSE: From the start, "A" boats will round Pt. Dume buoy "R12" to port, then King Harbor "G" mark to port, then to finish. Handicap distance is approx. 45.0 NM. "B" boats will race to a buoy located in proximity to Malibu Pier and back, about 34.5 NM. Detailed sailing instructions will be available at registration.

START: In the vicinity of "S" mark. The race will be started using the following signals. Times will be taken from the visual signals, the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

1155	Warning	Class flag displayed	
1156	Preparatory	P,I,Z,Z with I, or black flag	

Preparatory P,I,Z,Z with I, or black flag 1 sound Preparatory flag removed 1 long sound Start - Class flag removed 1 sound

The warning signal for each succeeding class can be made with or after the starting signal of the preceding class. Boats must sail by the Race Committee boat prior to the first warning in order to be recognized as a starter.

A CATEGORY 3 EVENT - RLC RATINGS APPLY

FINISH: Between King Harbor East Jetty Light (fl. Red) and the Committee Boat anchored inside the entrance. If the Committee boat is off station, boats shall take their times when the Jetty Light bears 100 degrees off the starboard beam. Notify Race Committee before Noon on Sunday, May 12th...

<u>RULES</u>: The Current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. Boats that fail to finish MUST notify King Harbor Yacht Club as soon as possible after retiring.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a <u>red</u> flag and notify the protested boat. Notify the RC when finishing. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed by 1200 on Sunday, May 12th. Hearings will be held before 1800 on Sunday.

TROPHIES: The Lobster House Perpetual Trophy for the longest series race will be awarded at the annual Awards Event at the end of the year.

FACILITIES: All participants are welcome in the Club before and after the race. Participating boats are welcome to use the KHYC overnight guest dock and hoist facilities. Call the KHYC Office for inquiries concerning the Guest Dock.
