1159	Preparatory flag removed	1 long sound
1200	Start - Class flag removed	1 sound

The warning signal for each succeeding class can be made with or after the starting signal of the preceding class.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat and notify the Race Committee when finishing. Protests involving class rules will be adjudicated by members of the respective fleets. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the Race Committee boat arrives at the front dock.

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the last race on Sunday, April 21st.

FACILITIES: Participants are welcome in the Club on race days and may use the KHYC guest docks and hoists.
