

KHYC 2002 Twilights -NOTICE of RACE

1. Rules

This series will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2001-2004 , KHYC "Course Chart 2002 Twilights" and its Sailing Instructions , this Notice of Race and any future KHYC Handicap Racing Fleet notices.

2- Eligibility

This racing series is open to all interested owners of sailing yachts. Membership in PHRF is not required. Yachts not currently assigned a handicap by PHRF will be assigned one by the KHYC Handicap Racing Fleet Captain. Buoy ratings shall apply.

3. Entering and Entry Fee

Completing a KHYC Race Entry Form prior to 1730 hours PDT on the day of the first race in which it competes may enter yachts. Only one Entry Form is required for the entire series. The entry fee is payable either before 1730 PDT on the day of the race, or in advance for the entire season series. Registration committee will be available at KHYC prior to each race to receive entries and fees. Fees are \$4 per race and series discounts are available. Yachts failing to enter and pay the fee prior to the race will not be scored.

4. Classes and Race schedule:

Races will be held most Thursday evenings beginning 4/18/02 and ending 6/27/02 for the first half and 9/12/02 for the season. Races will not be held on 7/4 .

First warning will be at 1825 PDT.

Start sequence of classes is as follows:

1830 CAL 20 , followed by :
Spinnaker B (Ratings 150 and up)
Spinnaker A (Ratings up to 149)
Multi-Hull
Cruising/Non-Spinnaker

The Race Committee has discretion to combine starts and/or delay the next start with proper signaling.

The Cruising/non-spinnaker class is open to any boat that desires to race. They must hail the Race Committee and declare their intention to be recognized as a non-spinnaker entry no later than their class 5 minute warning. Ratings will be adjusted from time to time to give everyone a chance to be in the winner circle. A running average of the last three races may be used for this.

5. Courses and Starts

All courses will be selected from KHYC Course Chart 2002 Twilights. The start line is restricted until the last class has started. Starting locations are as follows:

S Mark Starts

4/18,5/2,5/16,5/30,6/13,6/27,7/18,8/1
8/15, 8/29, 9/12,

K Mark Starts

4/25,5/09, 5/23,6/6,6/20,7/11, 7/25,
8/8,8/22,9/5.

6. Trophies and Series Scoring

Individual race trophies will be awarded by class after each race. The number of trophies by class size is posted in the KHYC Race Committee room. The Fleet will recognize class winners for each half series. Half series awards may be combined at the discretion of the PHRF Fleet Captain if the same boat wins both. For the series competitions, 1 throw-out per half will be applied. An additional throw-out can be awarded per Season for a boat that does not compete because of Race Committee duty in the same half season.

Series scoring will be low point:1 pt. for first; DNS and DNF, number of starters + 1 pt. ;DSQ number of starters + 2 pts. Entering 50% or more of the races is required to qualify as a series participant.

7. Class Flags:

Cal 20 J (Blue-White-Blue , horizontal)
PHRF B V (White with a Red diagonal cross)
PHRF A D (Yellow - Blue-Yellow horizontal)
M Hull W (Blue and White and Red
concentric squares)
Cruising K (Yellow-Blue vertical halves)
