Race #1 Sunday October 04, 2020 Race #2 Sunday October 18, 2020 Race #3 Sunday November 1, 2020

RULES: This event will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA and by the sailing instructions, as well as applicable class rules. RRS Rule 82 will not apply to this event. Only one man and one woman will be allowed on board. Spinnakers and gennakers are not allowed except in the spinnaker class. For non-spinnaker classes, only one headsail may be flown except during a change to a smaller head sail. NOTE: If you start with a small jib, you CANNOT change up to a larger jib. There are no restrictions on sail changes for entries in the Spinnaker Class.

Skipper Safety Protocol:

- Skipper of the boat will ensure that face coverings are available to everyone on the boat and that they are properly worn when within six feet of another person not in the same household.
- Skipper of the boat will confirm that each person has shown no such signs prior to admitting them onto the vessel.
- The skipper of the boat will provide washing facilities and/or hand sanitizer to all persons on the boat and will provide disinfecting sprays or wipes to sanitize equipment and frequently touched surfaces.
- Skipper will keep detailed logs of all persons boarding the vessel for purpose of contact tracing.
- The skipper is solely responsible for the safety and seaworthiness of the crew and vessel.

KHYC Race Safety Protocol:

- Pre-race skippers' meeting for post-race and award ceremonies, will be done online/or through an interactive video conferencing application or texting.
- Race committee: Registration and scoring will be done online.
- KHYC Chase Boat will be used to start and finish the races and will follow all protocols contained herein.. Rabbit Starts will be used if KHYC Chase Boat is not available.
- KHYC Race Committee will appoint a Safety Officer who will oversee all activities and ensure full compliance with these guidelines. Refusal to comply may be considered misconduct and can result in disqualification from participation in the event.

Entrants shall complete the online entry process at KHYC.org/Race Page and emailed to dorian.harris628@gmail.com prior to Saturday 5p.m. The entry fee is \$20.00 per race, with a \$5 late fee for entries on race day, or \$45.00 for the entire series. Entries fees will be charged to your membership number. Please included your membership number on registration form. Nonmembers need to submit payment to KHYC Office via a credit card.

VENUE: The race area will be per the current KHYC Mark Guide, the Sailing instruction and the Course Chart available online. https://khyc.org/web/pages/club-racing-info

DIVISIONS: Open to all boats. Class splits will be determined by number and type of entrants and will posted by 1115 online at KHYC.org before Race #1. One-Design classes may be established with a minimum of 3 entries for that before Race #1. In addition, a Spinnaker Class may be established with a minimum of 5 entries for that class.

<u>COURSES:</u> Courses will be per the His n Hers course chart. All Non-Spinnaker classes will sail the same course on each day as determined by race day sailing conditions. The Spinnaker class may be given alternate courses at the discretion of the Race Committee.

PENALTY SYSTEM: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the two turn penalty is replaced by the one turn penalty. Rule 44.3 will not apply.

SCORING: PHRF Random Leg (RLC) handicaps will apply with Time on Time (TOT) scoring. Non-spinnaker offsets will be used for boats sailing without spinnakers. Individual classes will be scored separately as a series in accordance with the Low Point system in appendix A 4.1 and A 9 of the Racing Rules to determine class winners. The overall series winner will be determined by scoring all non-spinnaker classes together in the same manner as the individual class scoring. There will be no throw outs.

TROPHIES: Both racers on award-winning boats shall receive trophies. Individual class trophies will be awarded. Contact Race Chair, Dorian Harris for pick-up instructions. Entries in the Spinnaker class will be eligible for trophies in each individual race but will not be eligible to compete for the Series Perpetual Trophy. Trophies for overall class winners and THE MAUREEN CASH MEMORIAL THROPHY for the overall series winner will be awarded as soon as possible.

FACILITIES: Due to State and County guidelines there are no post-race hors d'oeuvres.
