CLASSES: Open to all centerboard and keel one-design classes, and Multi-Hulls. Five boats will establish a class.

ENTRIES: KHYC will accept entries from members of SCYA affiliated yacht clubs or members of affiliated one design fleets by mail or until 1000 on Saturday Aug. 25th. Entry fee for USSA members is \$10.00 & \$13.00 for Non-USSA members.

RACES: All classes will race 3 races on Saturday and 2 races on Sunday, weather permitting. Order of start and sailing instructions will be posted by 1000 on Saturday Aug. 25th.

COURSES: Mono-hulls will use current KHYC course chart. Multi-Hulls will have a special course chart available at registration and inflatable marks may be used.

RULES: The 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA, Class rules and Sailing Instructions will apply as modified by these instructions and those rules on the back of current KHYC Course Chart. Boats that do not finish MUST notify the Race Committee as soon as possible after retiring.

STARTS: In the vicinity of "S" Mark

Races will be started by using the following signals. Times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.

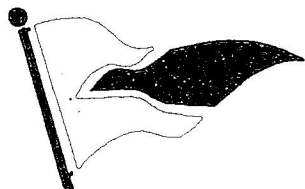
1155	Warning	Class flag or placard and Course No. displayed	1 sound
1156	Preparatory	P, I, Z, Z with I, or black flag	1 sound
1159	Preparatory	flag removed	1 long sound
1200	Start -	Class flag removed	1 sound

The warning signal for each succeeding class shall be made with or after the starting signal of the preceding class.

PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag, notify the protested boat and notify the Race Committee when finishing. Protests involving class rules will be adjudicated by members of the respective fleets. A written protest (forms available at KHYC) must be filed within 45 minutes after the Race Committee boat arrives at the front dock..

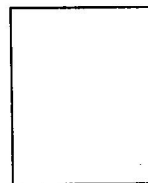
TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at KHYC following the last race on Sunday, Aug. 26th.

FACILITIES: Participants are welcome in the Club on race days and may use the KHYC guest docks and hoists.



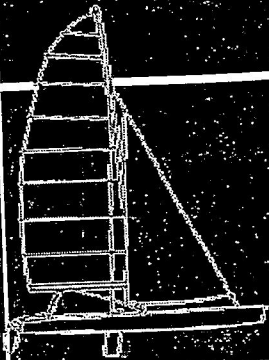
