DIVISIONS: Based on the entrants in the 1st race of the series, PHRF class splits are as follows: A (1-147) B (148-9999)

ENTRIES: Entries from members of SCYA affiliate Yacht Clubs who hold valid ratings will be accepted at KHYC & by mail until 1000 on race day. There will be a \$10.00 entry fee for USSA members and \$13.00 for non-USSA members.

STARTING LINE: Start in the vicinity of "K" mark and an orange flag on the RC Boat.

COURSE: Take R10, P.V. Buoy, to Port, leave Ship Rock to port.

FINISH: Between Orange flag on race committee boat and the Green Harbor buoy "C-1" (Lat. 33-26.98, Long. 118-29.57). Note: This buoy marks the West Side Harbor Reef which lies to the East. Be careful! Sunset Rule: The race will be over at sunset over Catalina from the Committee Boat cockpit. If the RC boat is not on station, take your own time when the buoy bears 070 degrees mag. off your Port beam.

STARTS:

1155 Class Flag	1 sound
1156 P, I, Z, Z w/I, or Blk flag	1 sound
1159 Prep. Flag down	1 long sound
1200 Class Flag down	1 sound

RULES: The current Racing Rules of Sailing, the prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions will apply. Boats that fail to finish MUST notify King Harbor Yacht Club as soon as possible after retiring.

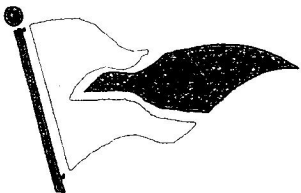
PROTESTS: Protesting boats shall fly a red flag and notify the protested boat. Notify the RC when finishing. Protests will be heard as soon as possible aboard the RC boat at the anchorage at Little Fisherman's Cove..

TROPHIES: Trophies will be awarded at KHYC at the annual Awards Event at the end of the year.

MOORING & ANCHORING Please make sure you have sufficient anchoring capabilities aboard (normal anchoring inside Little Fisherman's Cove requires both bow and stern anchors with sufficient scope and chain, as it can get very windy.) Look for advice from Cove Security if you require help.
