SPINNAKER SERIES - 2001

A PHRF series of 6 races, including point to point and buoy races on Santa Monica bay and the San Pedro channel, hosted by King Harbor Yacht Club.

This series is a qualifier for the ASMBYC Championship.

DIVISIONS

PHRF classes will be established based on the entries received for the first race and will apply for the entire series. PHRF area B handicaps will be used. There will be a spinnaker fleet and a non spinnaker fleet. Cruising boats are also invited to participate.

ENTRIES

The series is open to members of SCYA affiliated Yacht Clubs or Associations who hold a valid PHRF rating certificate. Skippers may be required to show current certificates. Multi-hull and One Design classes will be included in two of the races. There will be a \$10.00 entry fee for each race for USSA members and \$13.00 for non-members.

RULES

This series will be governed by the 1997-2000 Racing Rules of Sailing until the 2001-2004 Racing Rules of Sailing are adopted and distributed, the prescriptions of USSA and the Sailing Instructions on the back of KHYC chart #2001, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions for each race.

SCORING

The USSA low-point scoring system 2 will apply, except that a boat finishing first will be awarded ³/₄ Point. Each race will be scored separately toward the lowest total for the 6 races. KHYC scoring rules apply for DNS, DSQ, etc. There will be no throw-outs for the series.

TROPHIES

There will be individual take-home trophies for each event and Participation trophies for skippers who participate in all 6 events. Perpetual trophies: For overall winner.

Winner of the longest race in spinnaker series. Winner of the second longest race in the series. Winner of the Shortest race of Spinnaker series Winner of the Stoney Special - Race #1

Perpetual and participation trophies will be awarded during the Award ceremonies. (November or December).

HOSPITALITY

Participants are welcome to use the clubhouse, guest dock and hoist facilities (max.6000lbs) before and after each race.

Spinnaker #1 STONEY SPECIAL Saturday, March 3rd.

PHRF: A single-race event of approximately 13 NM around the KHYC buoys featuring some long weather legs and a variety of spinnaker sets.

A Category 4 event. (High Point race)

Spinnaker #2 TRANS HARBOR Sunday, May 6th
A 16 NM figure eight course between King Harbor and El Segundo, which
generally has some long spinnaker reaches. The course will use KHYC
buoys, an El Segundo buoy, and an inflatable mark.
A Category 4 event. (High Point race)

Spinnaker #3 PT. DUME & RETURN Saturday, June 16th A 44 NM race across Santa Monica Bay from King Harbor to Point Dume and return. PHRF B boats will race to a mark in the vicinity of Malibu Pier and return, approx. 34.5 NM.

A Category 3 event

(High Point race).

Perpetual trophy for longest race in spinnaker series.

Spinnaker #4 WINDWARD/LEEWARD RACE Saturday, Aug. 18th A 13.2 NM race rounding 10 marks. Two legs involve a wing mark and the balance are all up and down. A Category 4 event.

Spinnaker #5 Isthmus Race Saturday, Sept. 8th A 26 NM race, starting at a King Harbor buoy and finishing at the Isthmus of Catalina. Due to the wind pattern when you get close to the Island this is a strategic race. A Bar-B-Q and party at the KHYC A-frame on the beach at Little Fisherman's Cove should make this a fun race. A Category 3 event.

Perpetual trophy for 2nd longest race in spinnaker series..

Spinnaker #6 MATT WALSH RACE Sunday, Sept 16th This race tests your knowledge of the wind patterns in and around Malaga Cove and P.V. Point. Start at K mark, with R-10 as the weather mark, back to K mark, then again to R-10 and finish at K.
