

1996 CAL 20 NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS King Harbor Yacht Club July 10-14, 1996 NOTICE OF RACE

ELIGIBILITY:

A Cal 20 is eligible to complete in the NORTH AMERICAN CHAMPIONSHIPS if it conforms to the measurement rules, has been properly registered, is owned by a qualified active member(s) and the skipper has completed 3 regattas/series per the class rules.

RULES:

1993-1996 IYRU Yacht Racing Rules as adopted by the USSA, the Cal 20 Class rules, by-laws and rule interpretations, this notice and the sailing instructions shall govern the event.

ENTRY PROCEDURE:

Complete and mail the enclosed entry form with the boat's valid measurement certificate and fees as soon as possible. Entries who are chartering a boat shall provide that boat's valid measurement certificate to the registration committee. Full and complete registration at KHYC is required to be an Official Entry. (See registration information below.)

FEES:

Entry fee is \$125.00 for early entries received by June 30, 1996.

Thereafter, the entry fee will be \$150.00. (Checks to be payable to King Harbor Cal 20 Fleet) includes: Food at Friday and Saturday night parties for skipper and crew, participation awards, trophies, crew trophies and parking.

REGISTRATION:

Registration must be completed by 5:00 PM, July 11, 1996 and will include the following:

- 1. Sign off of the Checklist by the registration committee showing that all steps have been completed at KHYC.
- 2. Present proof of recognized yacht club membership prior to the start of racing.
- 3. Sign off by regatta measurer of the Regatta Measurement Checklist. Measurement will be made on a few selected items i.e. sails, keel, safety equipment. etc. prior to registration. The measurement checklist must be completed returned to the registration committee to become an official entry. A boat may be submitted for measurement no later than 5:00 PM on Thursday, July 11, 1996.

Registration for the Consolation Series will close at 9:30 AM, July 13, 1996. You do not have to sail the Elimination Series to sail in the Consolation Series.

LAUNCHING

All boats participating in the Elimination Series must be in the water by 7:00 p.m. Thursday, July 11 and must remain in the water until the conclusion of the regatta.

SKIPPER'S MEETING:

10:00 AM on Friday, July 12 and Saturday, July 13.

TROPHIES:

Perpetual Trophies: Cal 20 Class Championship, Cal 20 Junior Class Championship, Bud Gardiner Trophy for series leader after first day of racing, and the Gary O. Thompson Series Perpetual Trophy.

Take Home Trophies: Top ten finishers in the silver division and if there are enough boats, top five finishers in the bronze division. Top three finishers in the Junior Championships. Participation awards will be given to all entries competing in the Championship and the Junior Championships.
