KIRK ARNDT HAS BEEN SAILING SINCE AGE FIVE. HIS RACING EXPERIENCE INCLUDES DINGHY'S AS WELL AS FOUR KENWOOD CUPS, TRANSPAC, MEXORCS, J24 WORLDS AND NATIONALS AND THE J24 INTERNATIONAL MATCH RACING CHAMPIONSHIPS. HE NOW RACES HIS OWN INTERNATIONAL 14 HIGH PERFORMANCE DINGHY.

HE HAS ALSO REPRESENTED THE UNITED STATES IN INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION ABOARD 5.5 METERS (SWEDEN&ITALY), IN FINNS (IRELAND, GERMANY AND GREECE), AND TEMPESTS (HOLLAND, CANADA). HE ALSO FOUND TIME TO BE AN M-SCOW CHAMPION IN 1973 AND A C-SCOW CHAMP IN 1983.

SKIP DICKEL CREWED FOR ANDY SCHOTTLE IN WINNING THE PRESTIGIOUS C-SCOW CHAMPIONSHIP IN 1983. HE HAS ALSO BEEN VERY ACTIVE IN RACING AND OTHER CLUB ACTIVITIES IN HIS HOME YACHT CLUBS.
