King Harbor Yacht Club 2015 "Twilights" Notice of Race-Second Series

1. RULES

The Racing Rules of Sailing shall govern this series. Sailing instructions will be available at the KHYC website and at KHYC.

2. ELIGIBILITY

The series is open to all sail boats with LOA of 20 feet or more. PHRF (BUOY) rating handicaps will be applied. Boats without a PHRF rating shall notify the HRF Fleet Captain prior to the race to obtain a rating based on similar boat handicaps. Two (2) boats will be required to form a fleet.

3. ENTERING AND ENTRY FEE

Boats may enter by completing a KHYC Twilight Entry Card prior to 1730 hours PDT on the day of the first race in which it competes. Only one Entry Card is required for the entire series. The entry fee is payable either before 1730 on the day of the race or in advance for the entire series. A Registration Committee will be available at KHYC prior to each race to receive entries and fees. Fees are \$7.00 per race. Series discounts are available for those signing up in advance for the series. Boats failing to enter and pay the fee prior to the race will not be scored.

4. CLASSES AND RACE SCHEDULE

Races will be held **Thursday evenings beginning 6/18/15 and ending 9/10/15**. The warning signal for the first start will be at 1805. Start time and classes are as follows:

1810 Cal 20's	(One Design) Class Flag "W"
1815 PHRF A	Class Flag "D"
1820 PHRF B	Class Flag "E"
	Class Flag "M"
-	(Fluctuating rating same as 2014)Class Flag "H"

Boats wishing to compete as Non-Spinner in Class **A or B** must declare their status at **time of sign-up** to receive their PHRF spinnaker offset. Boats in **H** class are **not required** to declare their Spinnaker status in advance.

5. COURSES, STARTS AND TIME LIMIT

All courses will be selected from KHYC Twilight Race Chart for 2015.

The start line is restricted until the last class has started! Boats not finishing by 2030 will be scored as DNF.

6. TROPHIES AND SEASON SCORING

Individual race trophies will be awarded by class after each race with the number of trophies determined by class size and KHYC Trophy Policy. A class with two boats one trophy will be given. A class with three to five boats two trophies will be given. RRS (A4.2) is modified as follows: Season scoring will be low point: 1 point for first. DNS or DNF will be scored "number of starters +1 point", for DSQ number of starters +2 points. Time on Time" scoring will be used. Two throw outs will be applied for each half. A boat must enter at 50% of races for the series to qualify as a participant.
